I am an American! Growing up I was taught that I could do anything I wanted in life, as long as I was willing to work for it. That is how many people in our country are raised; to never give up on their dreams, to pull themselves up by their bootstraps, and make something of themselves no matter what their background. That way of thinking works great for reaching a better life, but it doesn't work at all when it comes to reaching eternal life. Because on our own Heaven is completely unattainable. You would have more success in jumping to the moon than you would in getting to Heaven by your own works. Left to ourselves we are stubborn, prideful, sinful, and utterly hopeless. I have often said that I wouldn't trust the best fifteen minutes that I have ever lived to get me into Heaven. Praise God that Jesus Christ has done the work that I couldn't; He took away my sins and gave me eternal life when I certainly didn't deserve it. Any chance you had of getting to Heaven on your own was destroyed by sin. Christ destroyed the power of sin on the cross to give you eternal life, if you would only trust in Him. Put your faith in Christ not yourself for eternal life. It is His work alone that can save you. That is the Gospel message. That is what we are talking about this morning: getting the message right.
